






## ABAN IN IRAN



The title of this piece was chosen to offer a clue to the audience and steer them in a route known to most people towards my small geography. And the scenario at one point caused the name of the inhabitants of this geography to reach the ears of many people globally. And I witnessed a very unfortunate and shameful situation from those who had only a human body and filled the void of their hearts with obedience to a superior order, with a piece of bread soaked in my brother's blood in their hands. 






## Unpleasant conditions make life a worthwhile attempt

I believe that aiming for liberty entails attempting to take advantage of the circumstances. And this endeavor, with all of its ups and downs, signifies life. Perhaps it is the sometimes unpleasant restrictions and conditions that make life a worthwhile attempt for all human beings. This endeavor becomes much more attractive and delightful for you and me when there are no borders and border guards.

There is a photo of me during a time when such concerns (not only geographic borders) dominate my thoughts, and I unconsciously, formally, and by continuing to build abstract lines and processes, create a picture. And the outcome of this process is a picture titled "Boundry."





Sometimes, in the final phases, my work undergoes changes that don't significantly alter its look. However, the work progresses to the point when even a line or a slight hint of color can take on the role of declaring its completion, and with this transformation comes the peace of mind that announces my mutual contentment with the work. This was achieved in "crust" by placing a green curving line on the black substrate and using light yellows.







I presented the proportions of this painting in an unexpected way. Of course, like all my work, no vision of the conclusion of the work is developed in my mind, but always at the beginning of my work, the desire to start work as soon as possible becomes a tool that I have a constant start and therefore Faces unanticipated changes. In this work, light paradoxically appears on the surface, in yellow, sometimes overtly and sometimes covertly. Gravity is defied in one scenario, while green grasses grow in the opposite direction of reality in another. And these things demonstrate, to some extent, my interest in physics and the issue of space-time at work.


## NO6. EVERYTHING, ALL COLOR


# EXISTENCE




are part of the censoring, part of the journey.





This is a situation that we are all familiar with.






